






PASA estimates virtually all DSISD students have returned from COVID-induced at-home or alternative virtual schooling.


Happened in tandem with an already-projected increase in housing in DSISD

Economy


Employment is back to pre-pandemic levels, however, inflation and increasing interest rates could slow the already stabilizing housing market, especially amongst certain buyers such as investors.












Five-Year Numeric Change in Enrollment








Annual Growth Rates



Historical Growth by Grade Group








 - Mortgage rates rising in '22







Annual Housing Starts




Single-Family in DSISD






Multi-Family Housing in DSISD













Projected New Housing Occupancies






Changes Since Last Year

 Cannon Ranch, Cannon East, Wild Ridge














Projected Growth in Elementary Students




