DSISD BOND IS APPROVED; STROUD AND JONES WIN BOARD SEATS

DRIPPING SPRINGS, Texas— According to unofficial results from Hays County, Dripping Springs ISD's \$92,410,000 bond referendum was approved by a margin of +16.5 percent (1,666-1,194 votes). In addition, Barbara Stroud and Ron Jones have been elected to three-year terms on the Dripping Springs Independent School District Board of Trustees.

Vote totals were as follows:

AGAINST	1,194	41.75%

Board of Trustees:

Barbara Stroud	1,262	33.47%
Ron Jones	1,037	27.51%
Alan Atwood	1,028	27.27%
Wayne Egeler	443	11.75%

The positions had been held by Mr. Atwood and Ms. Stroud.

The bond package includes funding for a new elementary school and a new middle school on Sawyer Ranch Road, a new multi-purpose stadium at the existing competition field behind Dripping Springs High School, HVAC system and roof replacements at some schools, a baseball/softball complex at Dripping Springs High School, a public access road connecting Dripping Springs High School to Highway 290, district-wide technology renovations and other infrastructure improvements, and expansion of high school field house/locker room facilities.
