DSISD HONORS DISTRICT TEACHERS OF THE YEAR

DRIPPING SPRINGS, Texas—Dripping Springs Independent School District (DSISD) announced the 2014 Elementary and Secondary Teachers of the Year at last night's Board of Trustees meeting. The Secondary Teacher of the Year was Karol Holden, U.S. history teacher at Dripping Springs Middle School, and Lindsey Thomas, art teacher at Walnut Springs Elementary School. These individuals will now represent Dripping Springs ISD in the 2014-15 Texas Teacher of the Year program.

Karol Holden is in her 10th year teaching American History and pre-AP American History at Dripping Springs Middle School. Mrs. Holden also taught for 18 years in Frenship ISD in Lubbock, where she also coached two state-champion Future Problem Solving teams. She earned a bachelor's degree in Secondary Education from Texas Tech University, and is certified in Gifted and Talented.

Lindsey Thomas has spent all six years of her teaching career in DSISD, three years at Rooster Springs Elementary and the past three at Walnut Springs Elementary. Mrs. Thomas earned a bachelor's degree in Studio Art from Texas State University with an all-level certification in art education (PK-12).
