DRIPPING SPRINGS ISD HIRES NEW COMMUNITY SERVICES DIRECTOR

DRIPPING SPRINGS, Texas – At the Jan. 26 meeting, the Dripping Springs ISD Board of Trustees approved Superintendent Bruce Gearing’s recommendation to hire Lucy Hansen as the new Director of Community Services.

Ms. Hansen has spent the past 15 years with Pottsboro ISD, including the past 11 and a half years as principal of Pottsboro Intermediate School. She started her career as a Special Education teacher, working in both Austin ISD and Sherman ISD, and also spent one year as an Assistant Athletic Director for Academic Affairs at Lamar University. While in Pottsboro, Ms. Hansen served as executive director of the Pottsboro ISD Education Foundation and as a member of the Pottsboro City Council. A native of Austin, she earned both her bachelor’s and master’s degrees in education from The University of Texas.

The DSISD Community Services Department offers many programs to students, staff, parents and community members including child care facility, extended child care services, elementary enrichment programs, summer camps, adult education opportunities, and online classes.

Ms. Hansen will begin her new position at DSISD sometime in February.
