DSISD TO HOLD PUBLIC FORUM ON BUILDING DESIGN SEPT. 16

DRIPPING SPRINGS, Texas – Dripping Springs ISD will hold a public forum to provide an update on the preliminary schematic design of the elementary school and middle school included in the bond program approved by voters in May and to gather public feedback. The forum will begin at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 16, preceding the Board's monthly agenda review meeting. Architects from Huckabee will share preliminary design ideas and provide background information. Public comment will be invited and questions will be addressed both by the architects and district leaders.

The schools will be built on district-owned property on Sawyer Ranch Road just north of the Highpointe subdivision. They will be connected to achieve efficiencies and make the best use of the land. The elementary school will be built to serve 850 students in pre-K through fifth grade. The middle school will initially be built to serve 850 students as well, but will master planned for expansion to 1,200 students. The campus is expected to be complete for the 2017-18 school year.

The Board of Trustees will consider approval of a preliminary schematic design at the Sept. 22 Board meeting. Information on the design process is available at www.dsisdbond.net.
