Three Students Qualify for HOSA State

Several Dripping Springs HS students attended the Area 1 HOSA competition, three students (one in two events) qualified for the state level.

Senior Insiya Aziz placed first in Extemporaneous Writing and finished in the top 10 percent in Health Care Issues to qualify in both events. Hailey Daniel finished in the top 10 percent in Health Care Issues to move on to state; she also was sixth in Nursing Assisting. Sydney Haley advances to state competition based on her third-place finish in Pathophysiology. Other top-10 finishers were Tom Shively (fifth, Pharmacology), Lisa Deya (sixth, Clinical Nursing) and the team of Emily Argento-Bird and Liliana Reyes (sixth, Forensic Medicine).

The state HOSA competition will be held April 14-16 in Galveston.
