## **FREDENBURG JOINS DSISD IN DUAL ROLE AS ED FOUNDATION DIRECTOR/DSISD DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR**

DRIPPING SPRINGS, Texas—Lindsay Fredenburg is the new executive director of the Dripping Springs Education Foundation (DSEF). She also will serve in a dual capacity as the Director of Development for Dripping Springs ISD. The position is new; previously the Education Foundation was managed by a volunteer Board of Directors, a group that Fredenburg will work closely with as the organization moves forward.

“The addition of this dual position is a sign of our district’s growth,” said Superintendent Bruce Gearing. “Many opportunities exist for the development of relationships with businesses and other community entities that have the potential to benefit our schools and students. Ms. Fredenburg understands the value in cultivating relationships and will coordinate many of these efforts.”

DSEF Board president Joanne Cicala Inscore echoed Dr. Gearing’s sentiment. “Our Board is delighted by Lindsay’s arrival and what it means for the Foundation’s potential,” she said. “This hire represents an exciting and natural next step in our evolution as an organization. With Lindsay as Executive Director, we expect significantly greater ability to fulfill our mission to preserve and enhance the educational experience so ably provided to every student by DSISD.”

Fredenburg comes to Dripping Springs ISD from Holy Trinity Catholic High School in Temple where she spent two years as the school’s Director of Advancement and Admissions. While at Holy Trinity, she oversaw the school’s endowment fund, worked closely with donors, and successfully raised more than \$400,000 per year. Prior to her stint at Holy Trinity, she was the Assistant Director of Development and Relationship Management at the University of Mary Hardin Baylor (2012-14). She started her career as the Director of Sports Marketing for a private firm in Mississippi.

A 2006 graduate of Oklahoma State University, Ms. Fredenburg earned a bachelor’s degree in Animal Science/Livestock Marketing. She is married to Cody Fredenburg and the couple has two young sons.
