DSISD Teams at Destination Imagination

Five teams from Dripping Springs ISD competed in the Destination Imagination Capital Region Tournament March 5, and the team from Dripping Springs Middle School placed fourth in its division.

Destination Imagination is a creative problem-solving competition that presents teams of students with open-ended challenges. The Capital Region competition was held at Vista Ridge High School and consisted of more than 500 teams. The top one or two teams in each event qualified to move on to the state DI competition.

The "Bomb Brains" team from DSMS placed fourth in the Middle School Technical Challenge. The challenge required participating teams to create a vehicle that traveled using two different movement methods and propulsion systems. Also representing DSISD were two teams each from Dripping Springs Elementary and Walnut Springs Elementary. From DSE, the "Chicken Fried Awareness" team competed in the Elementary Scientific Challenge and the "Stars on Earth" team competed in the Improvisational Challenge. From WSE, the "Electric Inventors" competed in the Elementary Technical Challenge and the "#BaconSwagger" team competed in the Fine Arts Challenge.
