### **Applications Accepted for Off-Campus PE Providers**

Dripping Springs ISD is now accepting applications for providers of Off-Campus Physical Education for the 2016-17 school year.

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) allows school districts to provide required physical education credit for students participating in off-campus activities that meet state requirements and local policies, but requires them to provide a list of qualified service providers to TEA in advance of offering the credit option to students and parents. DSISD will be accepting applications between now and April 15, 2016, for providers for the 2016-17 school year. (Current Off-Campus PE providers are not required to re-apply for three years.)
