THREE VOLLEYBALL PLAYERS ON ALL-AMERICA LIST

Three Dripping Springs High School volleyball players have been recognized in the Under Armour High School All-America Awards Program: Morgyn Greer on the First Team, Autumn Rounsaville on the Third Team, and Ashley Waggle earning honorable mention.

The All-America Teams, which were announced by the American Volleyball Coaches Association Nov. 4, were chosen from 600 nominations. Requirements for nomination were that the student-athlete be in her senior year of high school, be nominated by her high school coach, that her coach be a member of the AVCA, and that all her individual season statistics have been reported.

Greer was honored as an outside hitter and was one of just 24 players named to the All-America First Team. She has committed to play at the University of Florida. Greer was the only Central Texas player to receive first-team honors. First-team selections will be invited to play in the Under Armour All-America Volleyball Match and Skills Competition (in conjunction with the AVCA Convention) in Omaha on Dec. 18.

Rounsaville is a libero for the Lady Tigers; she will play for the University of Texas. Waggle was honored as a middle blocker; she is headed to TCU next year.
