SIX DSHS STUDENTS NAMED REGIONAL HISPANIC SCHOLARS

Six DSHS students have received regional recognition in the National Hispanic Scholar program, as announced by the College Board. They are: Meredith Anderson, David Garcia, Tyler Reynolds, William Whitfield, Avery Bendy, and Alejandro Reyes.

To receive recognition, students scored in the top 2.5 percent on the PSAT/NMSQT among all Hispanic and Latino test-takers in our region. Regional recognition qualifies students to complete an application for recognition at the National Level.

For a student to apply for the National Hispanic Scholar program, he/she must take the PSAT/NMSQT in October as a junior, be at least one-quarter Hispanic/Latino, achieve the minimum required PSAT/NMSQT Selection Index score, and earn a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher by the middle of junior year. The national winners will be announced later this year.
