### **HONORS FOR STATE SEMIFINALISTS**

Several honors have been announced for members of the state-semifinalist Lady Tiger softball team, including 5A all-state players Kiele Miller and Camille Corona and Wade Womack as the Texas 5A/6A Coach of the Year. The Texas Girls Coaches Association released all-state selections and Coach of the Year following the state tournament.

Miller also was nominated for the Gatorade Softball Player of the Year, an award based on athletic excellence, academic achievement, and exemplary character. In addition, the pitcher was chosen as the District 26-5A Most Valuable Player and selected by the the Texas Girls Coaches Association as a 5-6A Legacy All-Star.

Corona was named to the State All-Tournament Team at second base. She also earned a spot on the All-District First Team, as did shortstop Riley Dunn, catcher/outfielder Danielle Northrup and first baseman Haley Odell. Other all-district recipients were Paige Leschber and Bailey Hudgeons (second team) and Sydney and Ryann Campbell (honorable mention).

Three players received invitations to play in all-star games. Miller and Odell will play in the Austin Area All-Star Game June 14, and Riley Dunn will play in the TGCA All-Star Game July 12.

Two Lady Tigers were named to the THSCA Academic All-State Team: Sydney Campbell and Lexi Poehl.

The Dripping Springs High School softball team concluded season on June 2 with 35-9 record. The Tigers were defeated by Willis High School 5-0 in the state semifinal game.
