### **TIGERS MAKE IT TO REGIONAL FINAL**

The Dripping Springs High School boys' basketball team capped off the season with the second-longest playoff run in school history. The Tigers advanced to the regional tournament where they defeated Laredo Martin HS 33-29 in the semifinal game before dropping a 58-42 game to Corpus Christi Veterans Memorial HS in the regional final. The Tigers were one game away from making it the final four teams that advance to the state tournament in San Antonio. The last time DSHS made it to the regional final was in 1986; that team advanced to the state finals. This year's squad finished with a 25-13 record.

"This was an amazing run," said Head Coach Craig Swannack. "To be able to make history with such wonderful group of young men was an incredible experience."

Several players received district honors. Richard Milliron was the district's Newcomer of the Year and earned a spot on the All-District First Team, as did Nick Breen. Harley Preston and Cullen Young were named to the All-District Second Team, and Bryce Kalsu and McKenley O'Neal received honorable mention. Six of 10 players received academic all-district honors: Nate Bondurant, Lane Dominey, Spencer Johnson, Bryce Kalsu, Matt McKiddle and Cullen Young.
