DSMS STUDENTS WIN SILVER KEY AWARD IN STATE VIDEO CONTEST

Three Dripping Springs Middle school students have won a Silver Key Award in the annual Student Video Contest sponsored by the Texas Holocaust and Genocide Commission.

Eighth-graders Seth Friesenhahn, Eli Tod and Dylan Wolfe submitted a three-minute video that addressed the theme "Standing Up for Others." The three will share a \$200 scholarship. The statewide Student Video Contest has two entry categories: a high school division and a middle school division, each with Gold Key, Silver Key, and Bronze Key awards.

A total of 16 DSMS students entered videos in small groups from Pre-AP ELA classes as part of the Anne Frank/Holocaust unit of study.
