Info Meeting on SRP

A meeting to share information on the Standard Response Protocol (SRP) being used in Hays County will be held Tuesday, Oct. 18, at 6:00 p.m. in the Lecture Hall at Dripping Springs High School. A 25-minute explanatory video will be followed by a Question-and-Answer session featuring DSISD's School Resource Officer (SRO), the Hays County Director of SROs, and Constable Ron Hood. Dripping Springs ISD parents, staff and community members are welcome.

The SRP system is used in all Hays County school districts as well as other public entities to ensure that first responders and site personnel are speaking the same language during an emergency incident. It is a process for working together in a coordinated and efficient effort. This system is implemented not only in emergency incidents, but is practiced in routine drills such as the lockdown drills held annually at DSISD campuses.
