BOND ELECTION CONTESTED

On June 18, an election contest lawsuit was filed to challenge the successful outcome of the Dripping Springs ISD May 2018 bond election. At the June 25 DSISD Board of Trustees meeting, the Board voted unanimously to retain counsel in order to file a lawsuit to validate the outcome of the bond election.

The District hopes to quickly and decisively resolve the disputed allegations in the election contest. While litigation presents a temporary interruption, we believe it will ultimately provide resolution and is a necessary step to the continued progress for which this District is known.
