BOND APPROVED; KROLL, HETRICK AND O'CONNOR RE-ELECTED

According to unofficial results posted by Hays County, Dripping Springs ISD's \$132,000,000 bond referendum was approved, 1,662-1,631 votes. In addition, incumbents Carrie Fontana Kroll, Mary Jane Hetrick, and Shannon O'Connor have been re-elected to three-year terms on the DSISD Board of Trustees.

Sharon Armke: 882 (13.38%)

The bond package includes funding for expansion of Dripping Springs HS to capacity for 2,500 students, construction of a new elementary school (#5), construction of a new Walnut Springs Elementary adjacent to Dripping Springs MS, conversion of the current WSE campus into space for the district administration and daycare facility, miscellaneous projects at Dripping Springs MS, Dripping Springs Elementary and Rooster Springs Elementary, turf and track improvements at Dripping Springs HS and Dripping Springs MS, improvements and expansion of the District Transportation facility, district-wide technology infrastructure improvements and maintenance upgrades, and land acquisition.
