DSHS LEADS HARVEY RELIEF EFFORT

The Dripping Springs High School Student Council has initiated a district- and community-wide relief effort to assist those impacted by Hurricane Harvey. Donations are being collected for displaced families and those in need of basic supplies. Collections are being done all day on Friday, Sept. 1 (9 a.m.-4 p.m.) in the front parking lot at DSHS. Donation boxes also will be placed at all DSISD schools, and accepted at the Sept. 2 varsity football game.

While all donations are welcome, some specific items have been requested:

- + Money
- + Toiletries/hygiene produces (sanitizer, soap, toothbrushes)
- + Socks/underwear
- + Tools (shovels, brooms)
- + Diapers/pull-ups/wipes
- + Cleanup supplies (trash bags, leather/utility work gloves)
- + Box fans
- + School supplies

DSHS is working with the Austin Disaster Relief Network to get donations into the hands of those in need.
