## DRIPPING SPRINGS HS PITCHER HEADED TO UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI

DRIPPING SPRINGS, Texas—Dripping Springs High School senior baseball player Lake Dabney signed a national letter of intent today (Nov. 18) with the University of Missouri. Dabney was joined by coaches, parents, friends and DSHS staff in announcing his commitment.

Dabney, a left-handed pitcher, earned varsity letters as both a sophomore and junior. In 2013, he earned honorable mention on the all-district team after recording three wins, a loss and a save in 10 appearances for the Tigers. He also posted 15 strikeouts and a 2.14 ERA and led Dripping Springs to a district title. Dabney is expected to play a key role for the Tigers under the direction of Head Coach Chris Payne again this spring.

In addition to his success at DSHS, Dabney has competed for the Austin Slam organization, leading his team to the Premier National Championship in 2013.

The son of Tricia Dabney and Jack Dabney, Lake has been involved in multiple community service projects during his high school years. Recently, he and other members of the Tiger baseball team have visited Walnut Springs Elementary to read books about positive character traits to younger students.
