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DSISD, SCHOOLS MEET STATE STANDARD

Dripping Springs ISD and all five of its existing campuses “Met Standard” in accountability ratings released August 16 by the Texas Education Agency. (Sycamore Springs Elementary and Sycamore Springs Middle School not included in last year's rating.) Schools are designated as “Met Standard,” “Met Alternative Standard,” or “Improvement Required” using a performance index framework based on four factors: Student Achievement (2017 State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness or STAAR tests), Student Progress, Success in Closing Performance Gaps, and Postsecondary Readiness. Performance Index scores for DSISD and all five campuses significantly surpassed the minimum target score in all categories.

Statewide, 95 percent of districts and 89 percent of schools “Met Standard” or “Met Alternative Standard.”
