Dripping Springs ISD theatre students will showcase their talents in upcoming productions at all three secondary school campuses this fall.

Dripping Springs High School will present Neil Simon's "Rumors" for two consecutive weekends in the DSHS Auditorium. Evening shows on Oct. 26 and 27 and Nov. 3 begin at 7:30 p.m.; afternoon performances are scheduled for Oct. 27 and 28, as well as Nov. 3 and 4 at 2:00 p.m. The convoluted plot of this fast-paced show involves four couples who gather to celebrate the 10th wedding anniversary of their best friends, only to discover what appears to be an attempted suicide. Tickets are on sale now; those purchased online are less expensive than those purchased at the door. Online prices are \$10 for adults and \$5 for students and senior citizens.
