FOUR TRACK ATHLETES QUALIFY FOR STATE

Of the 15 events in which Dripping Springs High School track athletes competed at the 5A Region IV meet, four Tigers have earned the right to advance to the State Track and Field Championships.

DSHS had two regional champions: Bryce Kalsu won the 800 Meters with a time of 1:53.27 and Justin Wright was first in the 110-Meter Hurdles in 14:93. Bryce's time broke the DSHS school record and was the fastest time in 5A this season. Placing second and also advancing to state were Hannah Biggs in the 100-Meter Hurdles (15.57) and Bobby Holt in the 1,600 Meters (4:42.14).

The state championships will be held at the Mike A. Myers Stadium at the University of Texas at Austin May 11-12, 2018.
