## DSISD ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR PE PROVIDERS

DRIPPING SPRINGS, Texas—The Dripping Springs Independent School District (DSISD) is now accepting applications for providers of Off-Campus Physical Education. The Texas Education Agency (TEA) allows school districts to provide required physical education credit for students participating in off-campus activities that meet state requirements and local policies, but requires them to provide a list of qualified service providers to TEA in advance of offering the credit option to students and parents. DSISD will be accepting applications between now and April 11, 2014, for providers for the 2014-15 school year. (Current Off-Campus PE providers are not required to re-apply for three years.)
