DSISD ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT ANNOUNCES RETIREMENT

DRIPPING SPRINGS, Texas—Dripping Springs Independent School District (DSISD) Assistant Superintendent for Learning and Innovation Greg Jung has announced that he will retire Dec. 31, 2014. Mr. Jung has been in his current role since 2008. Previously he spent nine years as the principal of Dripping Springs High School.

In his current role, Mr. Jung's department oversees curriculum, instruction, Special Services, GT services, bilingual/ELL services, Technology, Extracurricular Activities, counselors, nurses, professional development for teachers, and various district advisory committees.

"It has been an honor and pleasure to work with this district's wonderful students, parents, and employees," said Mr. Jung. "DSISD is a special place and I intend to continue to support the work of the district in providing an exceptional education for every student and a great working experience for every employee as a member of the Dripping Springs community."

While he was principal at Dripping Springs High School, the school earned an Exemplary rating for five consecutive years and was rated as either Exemplary or Recognized for eight years. Approximately 95 percent of DSHS graduates were accepted to college between 2005-08.

Before joining the staff at Dripping Springs ISD, Mr. Jung was the principal of Uvalde High School (1995-99) and assistant principal at Lamar High School in Arlington ISD (1990-95), after starting his career as a secondary science teacher.

A native of Kerrville, Mr. Jung received his bachelor's degree in Geology from the University of Texas at Arlington, his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of North Texas, and his Superintendent's Certificate from Texas Tech University.

"Mr. Jung's dedication to Dripping Springs ISD extends far beyond what is expected of a school district employee," said DSISD Superintendent Dr. Bruce Gearing. "As an instructional leader, Greg has brought energy, insight and innovation to our district. He has given many years of his professional life to help make Dripping Springs a great community in which to raise and educate children."

A search for Mr. Jung's replacement will begin later this spring.
