OPPORTUNITY FOR INPUT ON HIRING OF PRINCIPALS

As Dripping Springs ISD enters into a hiring process for two principal positions in the district -- Dripping Springs High School and Walnut Springs Elementary -- stakeholders have an opportunity to share their thoughts about what qualities candidates should possess. Current Principals Joe Burns (DSHS) and Julie Pryor (WSE) have announced they will be retiring at the end of the school year. The positions currently are posted on the district website and the process to interview and hire a new principal will occur over the next few months.

Superintendent Bruce Gearing has met with staff, parents and students at the high school to gather input, and similar meetings are scheduled at Walnut Springs in late February. The WSE parent meeting is Thursday, Feb. 28, at 7:30 a.m. in the Center for Learning and Innovation.
