DRIPPING SPRINGS ISD TRUSTEE STEPS DOWN

DRIPPING SPRINGS, Texas—Dripping Springs ISD Trustee Shelly Reeves has submitted a letter to Board President Carrie Kroll resigning her position on the board, effective immediately.

“Serving on the Board of Trustees since 2010 has been a great honor and privilege,” said Mrs. Reeves. “I have always cared deeply about the quality of education offered to children of this community and believe we have taken many positive steps to ensure that quality. However, health issues have interfered with my ability to continue to serve in the manner the position deserves and I will not be able to fulfill the remainder of my term.”

The next steps to fill the position will be determined by trustees at a future meeting. Mrs. Reeves’ term is set to expire in May of 2019.

“I’d like to thank Mrs. Reeves for her years of service and dedication to Dripping Springs ISD, during which time she has always put the best interests of our students at the forefront of decisions,” said Superintendent Bruce Gearing.
