TIGER TRACK: FOUR DISTRICT CHAMPIONS AND 18 AREA QUALIFIERS

At the District 26-5A track and field championships April 4-5, four Tiger track athletes won district titles and 18 qualified for the area track meet. In the varsity team standings, the DSHS boys' team placed third and the Lady Tigers were fourth. Boerne Champion HS won both meets.

Winning their events to claim district titles were: Bryce Kalsu with a time of 1:57.54 in the 800 Meters, Hannah Biggs with a time of 15.40 in the 100-Meter Hurdles, Justin Wright with a time of 14.62 in the 110-Meter Hurdles, and Lightsey Puryear with a time of 46.04 in the 300- Meter Hurdles. All four district champions will move on to area competition, as will the following 14 athletes/relay teams based on their top-four district finishes:
