The theatre department has built an entirely new playhouse within the frame of the DSHS Auditorium stage, bringing the audience closer to the production. The show features a talented company of actors and technicians in a classic 16th Century comedy. Curtain times on Friday, Saturday, and Monday will be 7:30 p.m.; there also will be a 2 p.m. show on Sunday, Oct. 29.
