CITIZENS' BOND STEERING COMMITTEE

MEETING #1 RECAP

The Citizens' Bond Steering Committee held its first meeting on June 8, 2022, at Sycamore Springs Middle School. The CBSC takes the work of the Long-Range Facility Planning Committee and develops a recommendation for a bond package for consideration by the DSISD Board of Trustees.

Committee members were first given a tour of Sycamore Springs Middle School by district and campus administration. CBSC Chair Jennifer Rodriguez and Darrell Pearson of PBK outlined the committee charge and process including future meeting dates. Superintendent Dr. Holly Morris-Kuentz discussed the Long-Range Facility Planning Committee process and the six recommendations that were presented to the Board of Trustees in February 2022.

Dan Wegmiller, Managing Director of Specialized Public Finance, Inc., next presented DSISD's bond history dating back to 1996 and reviewed past tax rates. Assistant Superintendent for Finance and Operations Catherine Knepp discussed public school finance including tax rate history, general fund revenues, taxable values, debt service and House Bill 3.
