## CITIZENS' BOND STEERING COMMITTEE

### MEETING #5 RECAP

The Citizens' Bond Steering Committee (CBSC) held its fifth meeting on July 11, 2022, in the Dripping Springs High School cafeteria. The CBSC takes the work of the Long-Range Facility Planning Committee and develops a recommendation for a bond package for consideration by the DSISD Board of Trustees.

Superintendent Dr. Holly Morris-Kuentz opened the meeting by reviewing and answering committee questions from the previous meeting.

The meeting's focus was to develop a bond package recommendation for consideration by the DSISD Board of Trustees at the July 25 regular board meeting. Each of the four table groups discussed which bond projects to include in their table recommendation with the goal of building consensus for the table. Split decisions among the tables on certain projects were further discussed and voted on by the entire committee.
