## CITIZENS' BOND STEERING COMMITTEE

### MEETING #6 RECAP

The Citizens' Bond Steering Committee (CBSC) held its final meeting on July 13, 2022, in the Dripping Springs High School cafeteria. The CBSC takes the work of the Long-Range Facility Planning Committee and develops a recommendation for a bond package for consideration by the DSISD Board of Trustees.

Ryan Gregory of PBK discussed 2018 bond election data and reviewed recent bond election trends across the state of Texas. After committee questions and discussion, each table reviewed and discussed the committee's bond package recommendation that was drafted during Monday's meeting. The entire group then discussed certain projects and made a couple of changes to the bond recommendation before finalizing its recommendation.

Lastly, Mr. Gregory presented information on bond campaigning and the next steps leading up to a November 2022 bond election.

The CBSC bond recommendation will be presented to the DSISD Board of Trustees at the July 25 regular board meeting.
