Dripping Springs High School PTSA

Scholarship Guidelines 2023-24

Dripping Springs High School PTSA anticipates offering four (4) \$750 scholarships (final budget permitting) to 2024 graduating seniors from Dripping Springs High School who will be enrolled full-time in an accredited college, university or technical institute in the summer or fall semester immediately following applicant's high school graduation.

Through our scholarship program, Dripping Springs High School PTSA works to support students who are focused on achieving life-long learning goals through higher education.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must meet ALL the following eligibility requirements:

- The applicant must be a Class of 2024 graduating senior from Dripping Springs High School.
- The applicant must be a current member (in their name) of DSHS PTSA as of March 1,
 2024. DSHS PTSA will verify years of membership.
- Applicant must plan to be enrolled full-time in an accredited college, university or technical institute starting in the summer or fall semester of 2024 immediately following high school graduation and that institution must accept funds from the PTSA directly to cover the costs of attendance.
- Applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 2.0.
- A completed application with ALL required documents may be hand delivered to the DSHS Counselors' Office OR emailed as PDF files to the DSHS PTSA Scholarship Committee at scholarship@dshs-ptsa.org and must be received by April 19, 2024.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

All documents listed below are required and must be submitted with the application in order to be considered for the scholarship.

- One (1) page (front only) resume listing school activities, community involvement and service, work experience (paid or unpaid, temporary or long-term), any activities outside of school, leadership experience and special recognitions and awards the applicant received in high school.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from any current or former coach, teacher, community leader, church leader, or employer.
- Copy of high school transcript.
- Essays of 150-300 words each to the following questions:

- What do you think would improve the quality of education at Dripping Springs High School?
- o How has a teacher or staff member at DSHS impacted your education?
- OPTIONAL ESSAY (Will only be used by committee to break ties among applicants):
 - Please explain any gaps in your resume (i.e. lack of work experience due to school activities or vice versa)

(The content of the first two essays may be shared anonymously with school administration and the DSISD School Board.)

SELECTION AND DISBURSEMENT

Selection is made by the Scholarship Committee, composed of three (3) to five (5) PTSA members, who cannot be parents of seniors applying for a DSHS PTSA scholarship.

All information disclosed on the Scholarship Application is confidential and will be used only by the Scholarship Committee for purposes of rating applications.

Scholarship winners will be announced at the DSHS Senior Awards Program in May 2024.

Applicants chosen to receive a DSHS PTSA Scholarship must submit a claim form and an acceptance letter from the educational institution to DSHS PTSA, PO Box 1620, Dripping Springs, Texas, 78620 or treasurer@dshs-ptsa.org by June 15, 2024. The funds shall be paid to the educational institution. Failure to meet the above deadline may result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
