

DRIPPING SPRINGS HIGH SCHOOL

Prakash (JAD) Jadeja Scholarship Program

Deadline: April 1, 2024

In conjunction with Dripping Springs Community Education Foundation a \$1000 scholarship will be awarded (as funds allow) each year to a graduating student at Dripping Springs High School who has declared an intent to major in an engineering or technology field. The scholarship will be based on merit participation and is not a financial aid scholarship.

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must be a graduating Dripping Springs High School Student
2. Have a current overall minimum unweighted GPA of 3.5 or a grade average of at least 90%.
3. Have completed at least three engineering or technology related courses at the high school.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must show acceptance at an institution of higher learning.
2. Complete an application form (to be submitted to the DSHS counseling office by the first Monday in April.
3. Applications must include a letter of recommendation from a school source (for example a teacher, counselor, administrator)
4. A letter of acceptance from an accredited college or university. If a letter of acceptance has not yet been received, a copy of the signature page of the admission application or comparable documentation may be substituted to demonstrate intent.
5. Unofficial copy of current transcript

SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants will be reviewed and scored by a scholarship selection committee. The committee to be selected as outlined in the memorandum of understanding that created the scholarship fund.

ANNOUNCEMENT AND PAYMENT

Recipients will be announced at the DSHS Senior Awards Ceremony to be held on May 15, 2024 and must be attendance at the ceremony to receive the scholarship.

Scholarship awards will be paid for the benefit of the applicant to the college or university indicated by the student. The scholarship monies must be claimed by December 31 of the year in which it was awarded, or it will be forfeited.
