



What does Emergent Bilingual mean?

When your child first enrolled in any Texas public school district, you filled out a Home Language Survey
asking you to respond to several questions about the languages spoken at home, by your child, and in a
previous living arrangement.

If you answered anything other than English to any of the questions, then the district assessed your student's English (and possibly Spanish) language skills to make sure that we recommend the right program

placement for your student.

• If your student's English language skills were still developing in any of the 4 language domains (reading, writing, listening and speaking), then we recommended that your Emergent Bilingual student receive support through our English as a Second Language Program OR our Dual Language (Spanish)One Way program if your student's first language is Spanish.



English as a Second Language (ESL)

English as a Second Language (ESL) is an instructional program for students who are Emergent Bilinguals. The purpose of the program is to increase the English language proficiency of eligible students so they can attain academic standards and achieve success in the classroom.

Features of the ESL Program:

- ESL instruction is offered in grades PreK -12
- Emergent Bilingual students receive sheltered instruction, to increase their English proficiency level
- Emergent Bilingual students in an ESL program students also attend math, science, social studies and other general education classes
- The ESL program provides total English immersion for students
- ESL students are given the support needed to effectively adjust to American culture
- ESL classes focus on student-centered learning environment and are delivered by an ESL certified teacher

Dual Language One Way

In the one-way Dual Language program model, students who come from the same primary or home language and or background have the opportunity to be bilingual or multilingual. The teacher or teachers provide instruction in both English and the primary or home language simultaneously.

Features of the Dual Language 1 Way Program:

- DL instruction is offered in grades PreK-5 at Dripping Springs Elementary School
- Emergent Bilingual students are provided with culturally sustaining, linguistically accommodated content instruction in both English and Spanish
- The goal of our Emergent Bilingual students participating in the Dual Language program is to become biliterate and bilingual.
- Classes focus on a student centered learning environment delivered by a Bilingual Education certified teacher
- The program maintains a 50/50 language allocation
- All students fully participate alongside their English speaking peers in subjects such as art, music, and physical education
