Elementary UIL District Contest

Sycamore Springs Middle School Saturday, December 2, 2023



When to show up: Check-in will **begin at 7:30 a.m.** All students should be at their event tables by 7:45. The contest directors will begin pulling contestants to the room at 7:45. The contests will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. **Students arriving after 7:55 a.m. will be disqualified from the competition.**

Note: Since Ready Writing students will have already completed their writing compositions; they are not required to attend the meeting on Saturday unless they want to see the results.

<u>Where to park</u>: Park in the parking lot on the north side of SSMS (by the football stadium) or the parking lot on the northeast side of SSMS (by the cafeteria). The doors at the front of SSMS will be open for those who park at the front of the school. Be aware that you will need an additional 5 minutes to get to the back of the school to sign in.

<u>Entrance</u>: Students and parents should enter at the CL&I doors (north side) or cafeteria doors (northeast side) of SSMS.

Where to check-in: Parents must check in their students at your school's registration table located outside of the SSMS cafeteria.. After your child is checked in, please have them go and sit at their event table.

What to wear: Dress comfortably. No school-identifying clothing may be worn.

<u>What to bring</u>: Students may bring money for the concession stand but do not need to bring items for their competitions. The exception to this is Maps, Graphs, and Charts and these students will need to bring their reference materials. Food and drink bottles are not permitted in the competition rooms.


<u>Parents</u>: Parents are asked to wait for their children in the cafeteria. Only participants, staff, coaches, and judges are allowed in the competition rooms.

When the contest is over: Parents are to pick up students in the cafeteria and check them out on the stage by the slide show. Students may leave after their competition or may stay until the results are posted. Contest results are expected to be posted by 11:00 a.m.

If your child will be leaving with someone other than his/her parent or guardian, you must send a note with your child and he or she must give it to the staff member at the time they sign in.

<u>Results</u>: Contest results will be posted in the cafeteria as they become available. Results will also be posted on the District UIL Website.
