Create a World Map

STEP 2: Label the following continents and oceans on your map. Use a black ink pen fine tip sharpie if possible. *Please check for correct spelling and capitalization!*

Continents: North America, South America, Europe, Africa, Asia, Australia, Antarctica

Oceans: Atlantic, Pacific, Indian, Arctic, Southern

STEP 3: Shade each continent a different color, except for blue. Then, shade the oceans blue.

STEP 4: Study the location and spelling of the continents and oceans.
