

Dear Parent,

The State of Texas 2016-2017 School Report Cards for Dripping Springs Elementary School, Rooster Springs Elementary School, Walnut Springs Elementary School, Dripping Springs Middle School, and Dripping Springs High School have been uploaded on the district website at <https://www.dsisdtx.us/domain/104>. Sycamore Springs Elementary School and Sycamore Springs Middle School did not receive a report since they were not open during the 2016-2017 school year.

This is a report required by the Texas Legislature and prepared by the Texas Education Agency. It is to be made available to the parent or guardian of every child enrolled in a Texas public school. The report provides information concerning student performance on The State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR), as well as information on student enrollment, class size averages, and financial expenditures.

The information contained in the School Report Card is briefly described in the “2016-2017 School Report Card Definitions” found at <https://tea.texas.gov/perfreport/src/index.html>. The reports for the Dripping Springs ISD campuses may or may not have all the information described because the information presented depends on whether a school is an elementary, middle, or high school. State law requires that the school report card display information about the state, the district, and the school. Where possible, the information must be reported by race/ethnicity and socioeconomic status of the students and must include at least two years of results.
